Drivers Club 55

'Drivers Club 55' is located in centro comercial Alaire, Moraira.

The business activities of Drivers Club 55 consist of Secure Car Storage, Classic Car Rental, Guided Tours, Technical Services and Car Valeting.

Apart from these business activities, the club facilitates a members club. Club activities are organised by volunteers within the Club, on a non-profit basis, and separate from the above mentioned business activities of Drivers Club 55.

Members of the club are like-minded people who enjoy sharing their passion for classic and sports cars. Cars & Coffee Meetings & Drives enable the members of the club to meet and to enjoy driving these cars in the beautiful surroundings of the Costa Blanca. In addition to passion for cars, members also attach great value to the social aspects that come with being a member of a club.

The Club will provide information and help, if possible, to any member when required.

Club members jointly bear the costs of organising these Meetings & Drives by paying an annual contribution, the amount of which is determined anew for each calendar year.

After payment of this contribution members can participate in the the Drives free of charge. Non-members and visitors can, in consultation and after paying a fee, occasionally participate in a Drive. Members have priority over non-members and visitors on Club events when numbers may be limited.

At the start of a new calendar year Drivers Club 55 will announce which events are planned for that year. The Club has the right to adjust this planning during the year where necessary.

Members of Drivers Club 55 receive a monthly Newsletter announcing the Club activities planned for the next 3 months.

Members and Guests attending all Drivers Club 55 Drives & Events do so at their own risk.

Members / Membership

A Drivers Club 55 member must be the owner / driver of a Club accepted classic or sports car.

The membership is for one individual and his/her partner (or family member).

The club accepted car is the car used for the club Cars & Coffee Meetings & Drives.

See under 'Cars' below for cars with which owners are eligible for membership.

Club members pay a yearly contribution. The contribution for 2025 is € 40,- .

If participation is granted, non-members pay € 10,- for each participation in an event.

Membership will run from 1 January to 31 December of the same year. If a new member joins in October - December, he/she will receive membership through to the end of the following year.

The Drivers Club 55 membership offers the following:

- -member of a group of like-minded people to share your passion with
- -monthly Newsletter announcing club activities for the next 3 months
- -free participation in the monthly Cars & Coffee Drives and other Events with priority over non- members

- -10% discount on the rental price of a Drivers Club 55 classic car
- -members welcome gift

After submission of the application form, Drivers Club 55 reserves the right to not grant membership.

Drives

The planning for the Cars & Coffee Meetings and the monthly Short & Long Drives Drives in the next 3 months is stated in the monthly Newsletter. The working method for drive reservations is as follows:

Approximately one week before each drive club all members will receive an invitation email:
INVITATION - Long Drive 'Beniarres' 19th January 2025 (example).

If you would like to participate, please reply to this email before the closing date for booking and provide the information requested in the email:

-number & names of participants -car you are participating with -menu choices (if applicable)

If your participation is accepted* you will receive a confirmation email from us:

CONFIRMATION - Long Drive 'Beniarres' 19th January 2025 (example).

Participation is only possible if you have registered and have received the confirmation email.

*Acceptance:

- -There may be a reason that we have to limit the number of participants / participating cars for a certain drive
- -Members & partners / family members have priority over non-members and guests, we can place non-members -upon request- on a waiting list
- -Long Drives include lunch, if in exceptional cases you want to join us but cannot stay for lunch, we will place you on the waiting list; participants who join the lunch have priority
- -The participating car must be a car with which you are registered as a member / that meets the Drivers Club 55 criteria
- -Applications are processed in order of receipt
- -Drivers Club 55 reserves the right to refuse participation

Short & Long Drives (unless stated otherwise in the invitation email):

Note: The lunch during a Long Drive is in a restaurant 'en-route'. This restaurant can be the finish of the drive or, if the location is a bit further away, we will drive together to the finish from that location. Details will be stated in the invitation email and in the Drive Summary document that all participants receive.

It is the responsibility of each individual club member to ensure that their vehicle(s) comply fully with EU and Spanish laws relating to vehicle documentation, roadworthiness and/or equipment required to be carried when being driven on the roads of Spain.

Drivers Club 55 cannot be held responsible for nor condone the unlawful use of a vehicle by any of its members whilst participating in Club activities.

Cars

In order to ensure and preserve the Classic and Sports Cars DNA of Drivers Club 55, the cars eligible for membership are divided into the following categories:

- 55A Vintage and Classic Cars > 30 yrs old.
Cars with historical and technical interest.

- 55B Modern Classic Cars ('youngtimers') > 15 yrs old.
Future classic cars with historical and technical interest.
Cars with a pedigree of sport heritage.
Cultural nostalgia or emotional value.

- 55C Sports Cars.
Cars designed with emphasis on dynamic performance. 2-seater, 2+2.
Performance takes precedence over carrying capacity.
Not a mass product, made in limited numbers.
Coupe, Roadster, Spider, Targa.

- 55D Special Cars. Replicas, Kit Cars.

Cars must comply fully with EU and Spanish laws relating to vehicle documentation, roadworthiness and/or equipment required to be carried when being driven on the roads of Spain.
